NOTE:

- ◆ In the academic year 2024-25, the primary focus for Tarbiyah is *Qiyam-e-Namaz*. School administrators are instructed to ensure that the teaching faculty, as well as senior students, prioritize offering Salah. This includes planning for spare time, organizing assembly lectures, and fostering an environment conducive to the practice of Salah.
- ◆ Ramadan planning will be flexible so that the Ramadan Activity Plan can commence, involving teachers, parents, and students.
- ◆ It is anticipated that significant events such as Ramadan Month, 23rd March, *Ashra Seerat-un-Nabi*, Iqbal Day, and Solidarity Ummah Day will be observed with a robust activity plan.
- ◆ In the session of 2024-25, Saturdays will be scheduled for term examinations.
- ◆ Summer tasks are divided into two halves. The 1st half of the summer task should be submitted on Monday, 01 July 24, and the 2nd half of summer tasks, along with the Science project based on low-cost materials/recycling, should be submitted between Thursday, 01 Aug 24, and 05 Aug 24.
- ◆ There should be one collective session for parents with a psychologist in every term. The school administration will plan it internally based on feasibility.
- ◆ The Summer Training Plan will be shared with the teachers, and teachers' summer vacation will be from 15-30 June.
- ◆ For LSRW preparations, teachers should incorporate activities into the lesson plan in the months of September and October.
- ◆ The Sports Teacher should develop the lesson plan and activities throughout the year, keeping in mind the sports week.
- ◆ In the Academic Session 23-24, other Events/Competitions like Kangaroo, HRCA, RAINBOW, A2Z, Catso, etc., are significant parts of Mukabbir Schools.
- ◆ Campuses can plan their trips during the first week of November.
- ◆ There could be changes during the Academic Session due to unforeseen reasons and events.

March	All about me	<p style="text-align: center;">Muslim Identity</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Encourage students to reflect on their identity as Muslims. Discuss the significance of their Islamic names, cultural heritage, and how being a Muslim shape their character
April	Ethical Patterns	<p style="text-align: center;">Islamic Ethics in Daily Life.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore the principles of ethics in Islam, including honesty, integrity, and compassion. Discuss how these qualities should manifest in personal relationships, work, and interactions with others.
May	Green Wonders	<p style="text-align: center;">Plants in the Quran:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Highlight plants mentioned in the Quran, such as the olive tree, date palm, and fig. Tell simple stories or anecdotes related to these plants from Islamic teachings.
August	Weather Patterns	<p style="text-align: center;">Miracles of Nature</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Connect natural phenomena, seasons, and weather patterns to the signs of Allah mentioned in the Quran. Discuss the balance and order in the natural world.

Develop awareness of individuals who play essential roles in the Muslim community, including imams, educators, and healthcare professionals.
October	Animal Kingdom	<p style="text-align: center;">Animals as Signs of Allah</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discuss the concept that animals are signs of Allah's creation. Explore how different animals have unique features and behaviors that reflect the wisdom and creativity of Allah
November	Sky and Water	<p style="text-align: center;">Wonders of the Sea and Sky</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Share simplified versions of Islamic stories about the creation of the sky and sea. Emphasize the idea that Allah created these wonders and the creatures within them. Introduce children to names of sea and sky creatures mentioned in Islamic teachings, such as fish and bird.
December	Keep Our World Clean	<p style="text-align: center;">Guardians of the Earth</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discuss the Islamic etiquette of maintaining cleanliness in public spaces, including streets, parks, and communal areas. Emphasize the importance of community cooperation in keeping the environment clean. Instill a sense of responsibility for the environment, drawing connections between Islamic teachings on sustainable practices.
January	We are one	<p style="text-align: center;">Unity in Diversity</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Emphasize the diversity of people, cultures, and languages as signs of Allah's creation. Teach tolerance, respect, and understanding of different backgrounds.
February	Festivals	<p style="text-align: center;">Celebrations in Islam</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Enhance students' knowledge of the diversity of Islamic celebrations and their underlying meanings. Enable students to understand the rituals associated with Islamic celebrations, such as special prayers, communal gatherings, and acts of charity, emphasizing the spiritual significance behind these practices.
